Technology becomes essential in the daily life of the entire population.

People can't go to Red Cross branches, but they keep needing our services (even more than usual). Lack of access/use of technologies + absence of digital skills put vulnerable people at greater risk of exclusion.

Main responses related to Digital Gap

Change face-to-face to online methodology (vocational guiding and professional training)

Teams training in online and digital skills and methodologies

Generalization of training in digital skills (all participants in employment and social projects)

Providing devices (borrowed tablets) and access to Internet (sim cards for 2 months)

712 members of Social Inclusion staff (How to training on line, Training on Moodle... Generalization of training in digital skills (all participants in employment and social projects)

14.306 participants trained in advanced and basic digital skills (workshops)

364 participants trained in technological and emerging occupations

Providing devices (borrowed tablets) and access to Internet (sim cards for 2 months)

12.668 tablets(*), donated by companies, were loaned to vulnerable people. They were mainly used to:

- . Following activities related to **labour insertion** (adult)
- . Getting acces to **school activities** (children and youth people).




















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
